

- Notes: •"Smooth" can mean originally planed and then weathered/aged. It can also mean "less rough"; for example, NatureAged band-sawn is a smoother alternative to NatureAged circle-sawn. Antique/Reclaimed Smooth barnwood options are often heavy to brown tones. A high percentage of Trestlewood's barnwood lumber is rough sawn (meaning it was circle-sawn or band-sawn prior to aging).
 - Barnwood products almost always involve a range of color tones. Gray barnwood lumber will generally have more grays than browns, but will often have some brown tones as well. Likewise, brown barnwood lumber will generally have more browns than grays, but will often have some gray tones as well.
 - WeatheredBlend barnwood lumber involves a mix/blend of antique/reclaimed barnwood lumber and NatureAged or Harbor Fir barnwood lumber.
 - Barnwood processing services often available at additional cost include: kiln drying, fumigation, edging (to more consistent width), thickness planing (to more consistent thickness), pressure washing, wire or nylon brushing, metal removal, and adding of profile (t&g, shiplap or wedgelap).

HewnBlend timbers involve a mix/blend of antique/reclaimed timbers with hew marks already in them, timbers (new or reclaimed) to which Trestlewood adds hew marks, and weathered timbers (especially in smaller sizes) without hew marks. OakBlend and HardwoodBlend products involve a mix/blend of antique/reclaimed, RubyOak/RubyHardwood, and new timbers. FirBlend timbers are resawn fir timbers from a mix/blend of reclaimed and new sources.



 - Trestlewood's skip-planed flooring products generally involve a mix of boards with some skip and boards without skip (smooth). A typical target is 30% of the boards with some skip and 70% of the boards smooth.
